Title: Amend Article V Section 2 of the Constitution of the Department of Tennessee

WHEREAS, Article V Section 2 of the Department Constitution currently states; At the Department Convention, each chartered Post of The American Legion in the state shall be entitled to five delegates and five alternates; provided the Post has in good standing the fifteen members required for Charter; and
WHEREAS, This has led to confusion that each Post shall be entitled to more than one voting delegate; and
WHEREAS, Each Post selects one delegate to cast a single vote on behalf of the voting strength of the Post membership; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by Post 254, The American Legion, Department of Tennessee, in a regular meeting assembled on September 5, 2024, That Article V Section 2 of The American Legion, Department of Tennessee Constitution shall read; At the Department Convention, each chartered Post of The American Legion in the state shall be entitled to the voting strength of five delegates; provided the Post has in good standing the fifteen members required for Charter. One additional delegate is authorized and added to the total voting strength, for each additional fifteen members or major fraction thereof. Post membership will be calculated by adding the current paid Post members to those Post 2000 transfers completed during the current renewal year. No delegate shall be seated unless the annual dues have been received by the Department Adjutant prior to Post delegate selection. Delegates and alternates shall be chosen at Post meetings not less than one week before the Department Convention.
