Whereas, Legionnaire David Brewster served as Finance Officer of Post 78, Milton. FL; and


Whereas, Legionnaire David Brewster served as Commander of Post 94, Dresden. TN; and

Whereas, Legionnaire David Brewster served on the Executive Committee for American Legion Post 94, Dresden, TN.


Whereas, Legionnaire David Brewster served as Vice Commander and Adjutant for Tennessee District 9; and
